- 8 February: Save Valley Conservancy to Cecil Kop Nature Reserve near Mutare to Lake Chivero near Harare.
- 9 February: Lake Chivero to Mazowe to Lake Chivero
- 10 February: Lake Chivero to Monovale Vlei to Harare. Evening departure from Harare

Hooded Vulture *Necrosyrtes monachus:* One in Kruger

White-backed Vulture Gyps africanus: Seen

White-headed Vulture Trigonoceps occipitalis: One in Kruger

Lappet-faced Vulture *Torgos tracheliotos*: One in Kruger

Black-chested Snake Eagle *Circaetus pectoralis:* Seen at Mpempe Pan and in Zimbabwe

Brown Snake Eagle *Circaetus cinereus*: Seen a few times

Southern Banded Snake Eagle *Circaetus fasciolatus:* One male seen quite well at St Lucia on the first day, and a pair superbly well on the second morning

Bateleur Terathopius ecaudatus: Seen

Crowned Eagle *Stephanoaetus coronatus*: One hunting low over the forest at St Lucia, making the monkeys mad, and another on the road from Kaapsehoop

Long-crested Eagle *Lophaetus occipitalis:* Seen a few times

Lesser Spotted Eagle *Clanga pomarina*: Seen in Burma Valley

Wahlberg's Eagle Hieraaetus wahlbergi: Seen a few times

Tawny Eagle Aquila rapax: Seen in Kruger

Verreaux's Eagle *Aquila verreauxii:* Seen at Save Valley

African Hawk-Eagle *Aquila spilogaster:* Seen at Panda and in Kruger

Lizard Buzzard *Kaupifalco monogrammicus*: Seen a few times in Mozambique and Zimbabwe

Gabar Goshawk Micronisus gabar: One in Kruger

Dark Chanting Goshawk *Melierax metabates*: Seen at Save Valley

Pale Chanting Goshawk Melierax canorus: One near Polokwane

Shikra Accipiter badius: Seen a few times

Little Sparrowhawk *Accipiter minullus*: Very good views of a pair in Sandton

Ovambo Sparrowhawk *Accipiter ovampensis:* Excellent perched views of a pair in Sandton

Black Sparrowhawk Great Sparrowhawk *Accipiter melanoleucus:* Seen at Save Valley, and nice perched views at Mazowe Dam

Pallid Harrier *Circus macrourus*: A male perched in northern Kruger

Yellow-billed Kite Milvus migrans aegyptius: Seen

African Fish Eagle *Haliaeetus vocifer:* Seen at Mopani and Lake Chivero

Common Buzzard Buteo buteo: Many seen

Augur Buzzard Buteo augur: Seen at Vumba

Buff-spotted Flufftail Sarothrura elegans: Heard at Vumba

Streaky-breasted Flufftail *Sarothrura boehmi:* A male seen briefly but at close range, and a female fairly well, at Monovale Vlei

Striped Flufftail *Sarothrura affinis:* Seen at Kaapsehoop; brief but good views

African Crake *Crex egregia:* Several flushed at Monovale Vlei

Corn Crake *Crex crex:* Excellent views of four at Monovale Vlei

Black Crake *Amaurornis flavirostra:* Seen at Gosho Park

Striped Crake *Aenigmatolimnas marginalis*: A female was flushed at Monovale Vlei

Common Moorhen Gallinula chloropus: Seen

Lesser Moorhen *Paragallinula angulata:* Good flight views of three at Monovale Vlei

African Olive Pigeon Columba arquatrix: Many in Joburg; one at Kaapsehoop; also in Zimbabwe\

African Mourning Dove (Mourning Collared Dove) Streptopelia decipiens: Heard at Satara in Kruger

Red-eved Dove Streptopelia semitorquata: Seen

Ring-necked Dove Cape Turtle Dove Streptopelia capicola: Seen
